“Truly Swiss and truly international”, Le Régent International School is a 3-18 independent co-educational boarding and day school. Founded in 2015, it is the youngest and the most modern of the international boarding schools in Switzerland. A dynamic and growing IB World School, it provides a multilingual and multicultural educational environment to over 250 students from 45 countries.

The school is committed to holistic educational principles, combining demanding academic curricula with extensive sporting, arts and public-speaking programmes, leading to IGCSEs in Grade 10 and the International Baccalaureate (or the Régent Graduation Diploma) in IB2. Language options are particularly strong and many students speak at least two languages fluently.

Located in Crans-Montana in the Valais canton, Le Régent's Outdoor Education programme comprising frequent expeditions, wild camping, ski-touring and cross-country skiing, takes full advantage of its stunning location to provide students with the personal skills and understanding of the environment that will serve them well in the future.

At the same time, Le Régent is proud of its commitment to contemporary pedagogy. It is an Apple Distinguished school and a large proportion of its faculty are accomplished and intelligent users of technology inside and outside the classroom.

Le Régent International School is an official examination centre for the IB Diploma Programme, SATs, LAMDA, IELTS and Edexcel IGCSEs.

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CURRICULA AND ACADEMIC REPORTING

Le Régent's **Junior and Infant sections** follow the **IPC** (International Primary Curriculum) and **IEYC** (International Early Years Curriculum) with significant input from the **UK National Curriculum**, the school's own tailor-made programmes and an important French and Chinese component.

Secondary Section

Students in Grades 6 to 10 follow a broad and balanced curriculum of academic and creative subjects, including language options for mother tongue and second language speakers. They prepare to sit **international GCSE** examinations at the end of Secondary.

IB1 & IB2

Students follow the IB Diploma Programme (**IBDP**) or the school's own high school diploma, **Le Régent Graduation Diploma**.

In addition, students have the opportunity to sit LAMDA exams, IELTS, and SATs. Academic standards are high, as attested by 2020, 2021 and 2022 IB, IGCSE and LAMDA results.

The school operates a trimester system with grades reported in December, March and June, **except in IB2 when grades are issued and the transcript updated in late October and mid-February**.

The transcript provides an overview of the students' academic profiles taken from each of the three end-of-term reports. Grades are based on the IB 1-7 grading criteria.

As in many European systems, internal grades are a formative grade to indicate progress throughout the course and therefore are not to be considered summative records of achievement at the time of grading.

Le Régent does not rank students, since they take a wide variety of courses with different combinations of Higher (HL) and Standard (SL) levels.

All students sign an academic honesty contract at the start of their IBDP studies. Further to this, and in accordance with NACAC's Statement of Practice and Good Principles, Le Régent reports serious disciplinary infractions to colleges and universities, with particular attention paid to academic malpractice, to issues that could cause harm to individuals or the wider community, as well as to enrolment status.
